7th Sense components are:

- A sounds detector that recognizes the important sounds for you.
- A fixed receiver with lights, bed vibrator and wake up morning integrated.
- A portable receiver that vibrates the belt and lit an icon representing the sound recognized.
- A base that allows to recharge our portable receiver and which is equipped with lights and a bed vibrator to the night.
